

Student Dress Code

School Uniform

School uniform is compulsory. All students are expected to wear their school uniform to school every day. It is expected that school uniform be kept clean and in good repair.

The school uniform consists of:

- Full length black trousers and black shorts.
- A dark green polo top with black, green and gold stripes on the collar.
- A bottle green windcheater with black, green and gold stripes and the school logo on the left chest front.
- A bottle green bomber jacket with black, green and gold stripes on the waist band and the school logo on the left chest front.
- A dark, bottle green bucket, slouch or legionnaire's hat for summer and a dark green beanie for winter.
- A green and white checked summer dress for girls.
- A bottle green sports skirt for interschool sports teams such as the netball and rounders teams. **The skirt is not part of the everyday school uniform.** It is to be worn by members of the interschool sports teams on the days when interschool sport is played.
- Special commemorative jacket/windcheater for the year 6 graduating class.
- Predominantly black or white shoes, including running shoes. These should be flat, enclosed and comfortable enough to play, jump and run in when outdoors. **Open sandals should not be worn to school.**
- Hair bands or hair ties in solid colours- bottle green, black or yellow (our school colours).
- Where students need to wear a hijab it should be in the school colours- black or dark green.
- The school house colours- red, blue, green and yellow may be worn to school on special days. Students will be advised as to where and when they need to wear their house colours.

Writing (or graffiti) on school hats or any parts of the school uniform is not permitted.

Hair

- Hair must be well groomed and if it is long it should be tied back.
- Hair should remain in the student's natural hair colour- no added colours or highlights are to be used.

Jewellery

- Jewellery poses a risk to student health and safety.
- Small studs or sleepers may be worn.
- A watch is permitted but is generally not recommended in case it is lost or damaged.
- **No decorative jewellery should be worn to school.**
- The school is not responsible for lost or damaged items of jewellery that have been banned.

Make up and nail polish

- Make up and nail polish are banned. Do not wear them to school.

Please note: Our school has a dress code and uniform policy. Appropriate dress contributes to a neat and stylish look and allows children to remain children when at school.

Label your school uniform- put your name on your tops, windcheaters, jackets and hats

Parents will be notified when the school is having an out of uniform day. When a student is out of uniform there should be a note explaining why. It should be given to the class teacher first thing in the morning.
